## DISTRICT III LEAGUE TEAM PLAYOFF PROCEDURAL GUIDELINES 2020

- 1. The playoff will be round robin, doubles format with 16 frame games.
- **2.** The District III League Coordinator will provide to the Tournament Director a list of the individual League team winners upon completion of League Team play.
- The League Team Champion Captains shall with the District III President and Tournament Director prior to the Playoffs to review the criteria for the Playoffs and to draw for Team court assignments.
- **4.** All League Team Captains will provide, prior to the meeting commencing, a list of Playoff Team Members with a number assigned to each member. This numerical listing of players shall be the Player Rotation Schedule referred to in ASA State League Team Championship Special Procedures (rev March 2022) and shall be followed throughout the Tournament.
- 5. The Tournament Director shall post the schedule showing League Team play and byes; and win and losses records.
- **6.** Three (3) courts are to be played in each round. One (1) point will be given on the winning court.
- **7.** It will the Charters responsibility, with the assistance of the Team Captains, to see that players DO NOT repeat play on the same court in the same position.
- 8. Fifteen (15) minutes prior to each round of play, the Team Captain MUST present to the Charters their Team Roster and Position (Head and Foot) to be played. This is strictly enforced in that round (no switching). Captains may change Position and/or partners for succeeding rounds.
- **9.** The Captain or a designated player will lag for color on a neutral court. A coin toss will determine who lags yellow.
- **10.** The Charters will post each team scores after each round.
- **11.** In case of a tie at the end of the game the ASA Official Rules, Section Scoring Rule E-4 shall be applied with the assistance of the Head Referee, until the tie is broken.
- 12. A two-way tie in the standings at the end of the playoff rounds shall be broken by a head to head comparison. In case a three-way tie that can not be resolved by a head to head comparison, refer to the ASA State League Team Championship Special Procedure Section O for a procedure of resolution.
- 13. Per ASA League Team Championship Special Procedure and District III Rules and Regulations, a player must have played at least 3 regular season games for the team in which they have identified as members.
