

# **EAST VALLEY LEAGUE – DISTRICT IV**

## **Teams**

10/25/2021

1. Teams must be mixed gender, minimum of one male or female per team and who must play
2. Team members must be from the same park / community / club
3. Minimum of six players on a team
4. Captain will register the team and team members with the District and with the League
5. No League player can play on more than one team
6. Captains will register their teams using the Team Roster form found on the District web site
7. Any team unable to field a minimum of six players can opt to forfeit the game or try to re-schedule to game within 10 days of the original game (except for the final week of the season).
8. Teams unable to reschedule missed games will forfeit the game

## **League**

1. Four teams per league, three board format
2. Blind draw will be used to set up the League
3. League must appoint a President, Vice President, and a Secretary/Treasurer from the four captains
4. One half of the games must be played on the home courts, unless alternative arrangements are made through the League President
5. A \$10.00 League fee per player will be charged, of which \$5.00 will be retained by the League for awards and other operational costs
6. Any funds remaining after the end of the season will be returned proportionally to the Team Captains
7. Leagues may choose to play either Thursday afternoon or Friday afternoon
8. The team with the highest number of earned points will represent the League at the District IV League Playoffs

## **Players**

1. Each player must be a member of the District, which includes having paid their 2022 annual membership dues to the District prior to playing
2. The line-up of players for each game must reflect the “mixed gender” nature of the league

## **Games**

1. Games will start no earlier than 1:30 pm
2. Play format will be singles, games will be scored 2 points for a win and 1 point for a draw
3. Scheduled games will start on January 6<sup>th</sup> and all six scheduled games must have been played no later than February 18<sup>th</sup>
4. Games will be played in accordance with current ASA rules
5. Home team will appoint a Head Referee who will have final say on calls
6. The two Captains will use a blind draw to assign players to a specific court
7. Games will be 16 frames, with the home team always playing the black discs.
8. After the 8<sup>th</sup> frame players will switch sides of the court, taking their disc color with them
