

Proposed changes to the HALL OF FAME COMMITTEE SPECIAL PROCEDURES

RATIONALE:

The Arizona Shuffleboard Association (ASA) has never allowed an ASA member to accumulate Hall of Fame points in the non-sanctioned Bud Walrath National Tournament (The Bud). The Bud does play under ASA rules (except needing an ASA card) and meets the Hall Of Fame Committee Special Procedures B.2.d – “Any non-sanctioned district tournament played under all ASA Rules having at least sixty-four (64) entries.”. Since The Bud plays under most ASA rules and has 64+ player participation; I suggest we follow the same scoring system as the District Tournament point structure which is:

Points (per player) for placement	1 st	2 nd	3 rd	4 th
Championship	5	4	3	2
Consolation	4	3	2	1

Process:

According to the Hall Of Fame Committee Special Procedures section H:

Any changes desired in these procedures must be submitted in detail in writing and mailed with the notice of a regular ASA meeting, or, alternatively, posted on the ASA website along with the ASA meeting notice in a timely manner. A two-thirds (2/3) vote of those ASA Board Members present and voting, a quorum being present, is required to approve any changes.

Notice of Motion:

I move to add the below statement to the Hall Of Fame Committee Special Procedures: Appendix A Player Category Scoring Guide to include in parentheses below the DISTRICT TOURNAMENT heading.

	Points (per player) for placement	1 st	2 nd	3 rd	4 th
DISTRICT TOURNAMENT	Championship	5	4	3	2
(Including the Bud Walrath National Tournament)	Consolation	4	3	2	1

Result:

All current ASA players placing in the Bud Walrath National Tournament will be allowed to accumulate the District Tournament point structure for their total points.
